Activity:

Match the Spanish word to the picture:

Baby Faye spotted something sparkling under a seashell.

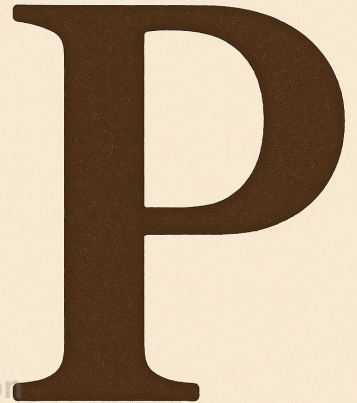
“¡Ahhh!” she squealed.

“¡Ganadores de Caza Palabras!” (Word Hunt Winners!)

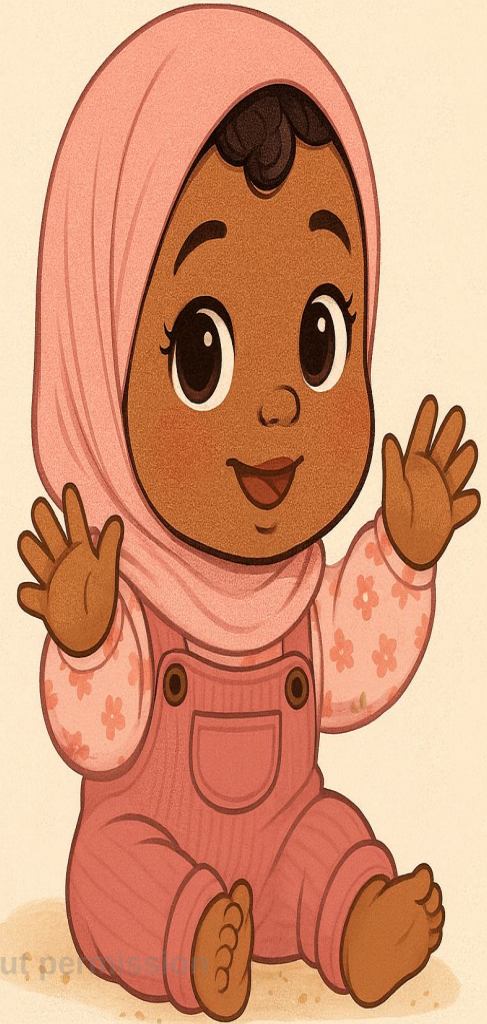
The kids cheered and shouted their new words:
